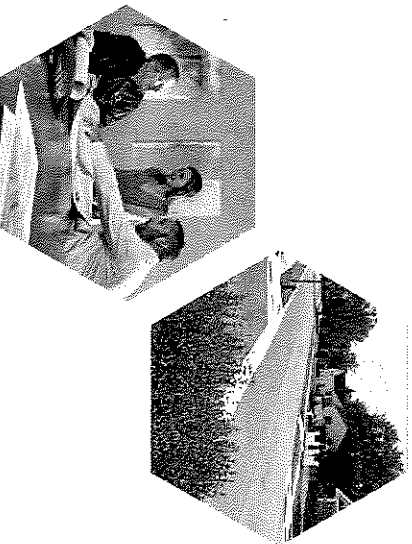


Project Design Details

- » Construction of a new sanitary sewer forcemain along the west side of CR 45, from 36th Street NW through Medford along 2nd Street NW to Medford City Park.
- » Driveways impacted by construction will be replaced in kind.
- » 2nd Street NW will be reconstructed with new bituminous pavement.
- » Lawns disturbed by construction will be seeded.
- » Some tree removal is required to construct the project.
- » Only local traffic will be allowed within the construction zones.
- » The existing Wastewater Facility will be decommissioned after the new forcemain and lift station are installed and operational.



Project Schedule

- » All work is required to be completed by July 1, 2026. The restoration of 2nd Street NW is scheduled to be complete in 2025.
- » Work in Medford is scheduled to begin in September, with construction south of town starting in August.
- » The project schedule and completion dates are weather dependent.

Project Notes

- » Vehicular access to driveways may be restricted during construction. The Contractor will notify residents when this occurs. Driveway access to affected driveways is expected to be restored at the end of each workday unless concrete is poured, in which case residents should not drive on it for at least 7 days.
- » Access to Medford City Park may be limited during construction activities in the area.
- » Road crossings (intersections) will be included in this project. Temporary detours and road closures will be necessary.
- » Utility interruptions may occur during construction. The Contractor will coordinate these disruptions with utility companies and property owners.
- » Garbage collection will be coordinated with the Contractor prior to construction. Please write your name and house address on your garbage cans, so they can be returned to you after collection.
- » If you wish to hire Heselson Construction for work on private property, work must be coordinate directly with them. Contact Jason Brandvold with any requests.

- » If necessary, temporary mailbox banks will be installed. The Contractor will coordinate the location with the US Postal Service.
- » It is the property owner's responsibility to make any special arrangements with the Contractor.
- » The Contractor is requesting that no cars park on the streets between 7:00 AM and 7:00 PM within the construction area.
- » Numerous locating flags and wooden lath will be placed along the project limits, within the ROW and/or on private property. Please do not disturb these markings as they are important tools for the Contractor. If you have any questions, please contact Cory Felderman.
